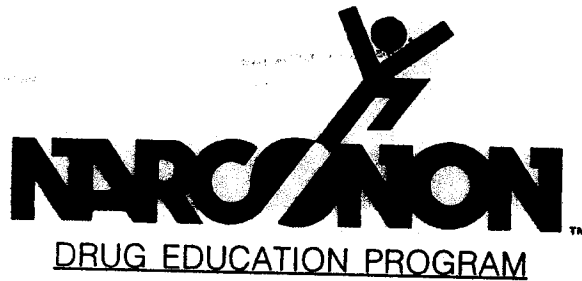

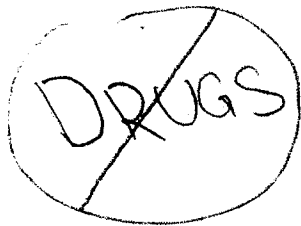

Because we now know what can happen to us if we do drugs, and how it's not good!

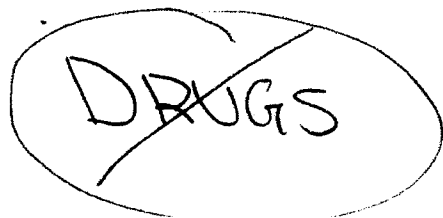
2) How did your thoughts about drugs change after hearing the talk?


