

Waiver and Release of Liability

The undersigned hereby expressly agrees to be responsible for any medical illness incurred in the treatment of any illness or accident. In the event of any such accident or injury, I hereby consent to allowing any of the camp supervisors to procure any medical treatment deemed advisable on behalf of my child or ward without prior consent.

I acknowledge that volleyball or any sporting event is an extreme test of a person's physical and mental limits and that my participation in a volleyball event can cause serious injury, potential death, or property damage. With full understanding of the potential risks, I hereby assume the risks of participating in a volleyball event. I understand that as a condition of admittance as a camper, the undersigned on behalf of all parents and guardians, and on behalf of the applicant, hereby releases Seton-LaSalle High School, Ray Bobak, all other employees or agents of the camp and the Greentree Sportplex and its employees and agents from any and all liability from injury or illness, mental or physical, suffered by the camper during or related to camp unless caused by willful or gross negligence by the person or entity against whom the claim is made.

The Seton-LaSalle Volleyball skills camp is open to middle school and elementary school athletes (grades 4-8) of all skill levels. Our coaches will adjust the progression of drills to fit the skill level of the athletes. This camp will cover all the basic individual skills involved with volleyball including: Passing, Serving, Setting, Blocking; Spiking; and Defense. Team offense and defense will be one of the focal points of the camp. This is an excellent team bonding opportunity and provides players the chance to improve their skills under the direction of some of the area's outstanding coaches.

Fundamentals will be stressed along with an introduction of the new passing technique. Development of a strong work ethic and an understanding of the importance of teamwork will be emphasized. Players will be challenged in all aspects of the game, and drills will be designed to strengthen existing skills and/or introduce new skills. The daily sessions will include 4 hours of quality instructional time. Each player will receive a free tee shirt.

Cost of the camp is \$60.00 per pre-registered camper for all four days.

Campers registering at the facility on July 18 will be charged \$70.00.
