

Teaspoon of Java

Due Monday, January 26, 1998

- Login to one of the sun computers in either WeH 5201, 5202, or 5204.
- Create a file `HelloWorld.java` that contains

```
public class HelloWorld {
    public static void main(String[] args) {
        System.out.println("HelloWorld!");
    }
}
```

- Check the version number of the java you are using with:

```
% java -version
```

- Change the default version of java to 1.1 with:

```
% setenv JAVA_1_1 true
```

- Add this to your `.login` file now because it won't make a difference for a month or so and then you'll have no idea what's wrong.
- Finally, compile (into byte code, not machine code, remember!) and run your program with:

```
javac HelloWorld.java
java HelloWorld
```
