Write a function named `print7s` that takes one parameter `x` and prints **every 7 numbers** from **0 to `x` inclusive**. Here is an example of what the function will print when called with `x = 28`:

```
>>> print7s(28)
```

```
0
```

```
7
```

```
14
```

```
21
```

```
28
```

```
def print7s(x):  
    y = 0  
    while y <= x:  
        print(y)  
        y = y + 7
```

```
def print7s(x):  
    for y in range(0, x+1, 7):  
        print(y)
```
