

Advanced Placement (AP), International Baccalaureate (IB), and Cambridge Exam Advanced Level/Edexcel (CE) Credits

Carnegie Mellon does give credits for AP, IB¹, and CE² courses. Typically if you score a 4 or 5 in AP CMU will give you credit. Same thing if you score a 6 or 7 in your IB or you score A or B in the CE tests.

4 in AP = 6 in IB = B in CE

5 in AP = 7 in IB = A in CE

What do you have to do?

You need to send me a copy of the official document with your grades. This is a copy of the grade report sent to you (high schools grades reports are not acceptable). It doesn't matter if you have already sent your scores to the Admissions Office (or any other office) at CMU.

At this time, I am only interested in the following subjects:

- **AP: Computer Science, AB Calculus, and BC Calculus.**
- **IB: Computer Science and Mathematics.**
- **CE: Computing, Mathematics C/Advanced Math (9371)**

IF YOU TOOK ANY OF THESE TESTS *PRIOR* TO 2018

I would like to send me a copy (or the original) of your scores. If you don't have a copy to send to me then you need to get one. You can contact the College Board directly and request a copy of all your test scores. Your high school academic counselor may be able to help you with this. You can also download a copy of your grade report from the corresponding website. A copy of your AP/IB/CE scores is needed for me to record your credits in the CMU system. **You can simply scan your AP/IB/CE scores (create a PDF file) and send them to me as an email attachment.**

Also, it may be the case that you took the mentioned tests in different years. For example, you took the AP CS test this year but took the AP Calculus BC in 2017. If that is the case I need you to send me your scores in these tests if you have them. **You can simply scan your AP/IB/CE scores (create a PDF file) and send them to me as an email attachment.**
