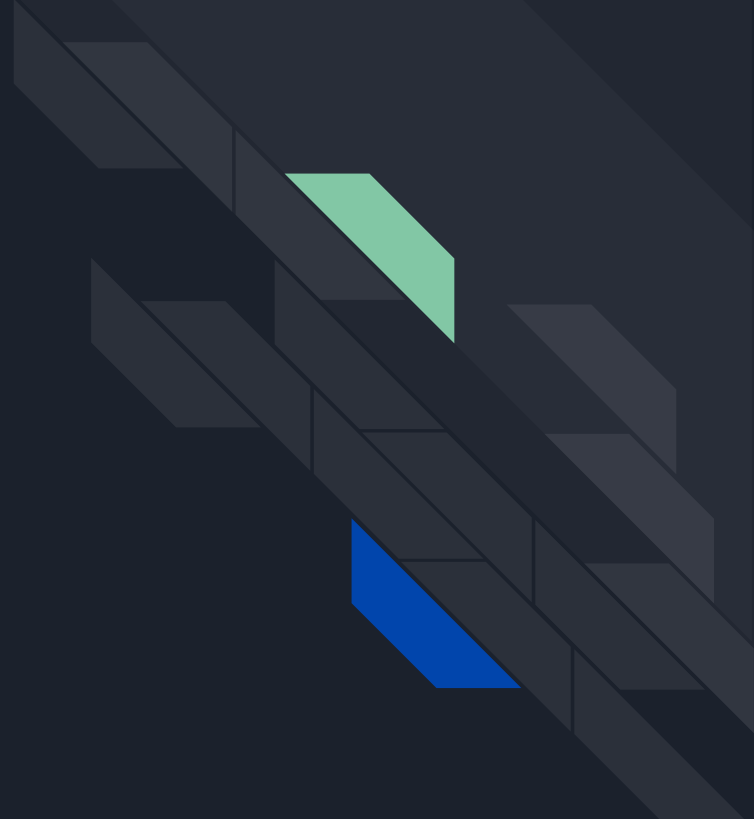

- Open Terminal
- ls -a in home
- cd into ssh directory and open config with vim.
- Examine contents

oh-my-zsh

1. Install zsh

- Follow instructions [here](#) for your OS

2. Install oh-my-zsh

- `sh -c "$(curl -fsSL https://raw.githubusercontent.com/ohmyzsh/ohmyzsh/master/tools/install.sh)"`

3. Look at the config file!

- `vim ~/.zshrc`

 - Install fonts as described [here](#)
 - `git clone --depth=1 https://github.com/romkatv/powerlevel10k.git`
`_${ZSH_CUSTOM:-$HOME/.oh-my-zsh/custom}/themes/powerlevel10k`
 - Set `ZSH_THEME="powerlevel10k/powerlevel10k"` in your `~/.zshrc`

Plugins

- 1. git**
Super useful git shortcuts i.e. `gcam = git commit -a -m` with documentation [here](#)
- 2. zsh-autosuggestions**
Suggest potential completion of current command with install instructions [here](#)
- 3. fasd**
Easily jump around directories with “fuzzy search”, install instructions [here](#)
- 4. zsh-syntax-highlighting**
Syntax highlighting for zsh shell commands, with install instructions [here](#)
- 5. colored-man-pages**
Colorize man pages for easier visualization
- 6. Tons More**
