

## Fact-and-Reflection (FaR) Improves Confidence Calibration of Large Language Models




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(A) Goal: How prompting strategies influence model confidence calibration?


Prompting influence performance for LLM;

What about their self-reported confidence?

- 1. Example on the right shows there is some influence!
- 2.How to *systematically* study this effect?




It can not, my confidence is 95%.

(a) ECE: a stable overall measure

(b) MacroCE: sensitive instance-level measure



Method	ECE	MacroCE
Standard	30.3	54.6
Self-Ask (a.)	26.0	66.0
FaR	22.8	47.0

- Token Prob.
  Accuracy

  0.0 0.1 0.2 0.3 0.4 0.5 0.6 0.7 0.8
- 1.FaR reduces
  calibration error
- 2.FaR expresses concerns on hard examples (e.g., Source is not credible)
- 3. FaR also works for open-source models!
